### **Quote For Reflection**

The principles of the Beatitudes are missing in today's Church. The Beatitudes have intense significance in a world where many Christians want to change others. The Beatitudes express the idea that peace comes from peacemakers who are characterized by their poverty of spirit, their ability to mourn for the world, their lack of attachments or clinging to personal rights, their hunger for the healing of the world, their extreme mercy extended even towards their worst enemies, and their purity of heart. Peacemakers, according to Christ, are the instruments who bring peace to the world because they exemplify these characteristics. Change comes from the inside and moves towards the external.

The Beatitudes teach us how to **"be peace,"** not just be *at* peace, but to **become peace** so that peace can spread, and that peace can come from being rooted both in the life of God and in the physical world.
