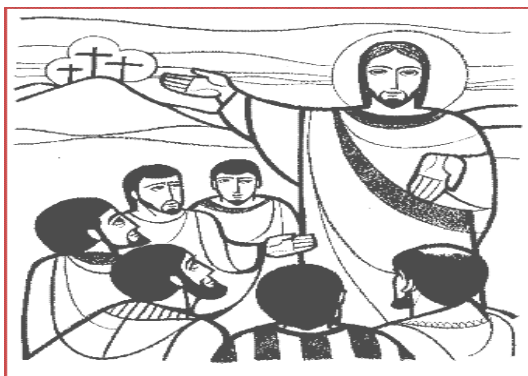

It Was Not All Given To Peter

And I tell you that you are Peter, and on this rock I will build my church, and the gates of Hades will not overcome it.

The Greek word for Peter means rock (Petros). When translated in English it means; a fragment of a rock. Jesus was not stating that Peter would be the only rock on which He would build His church, but it started with Peter.

Jesus Christ however is the 'Petra' (the immovable stone).

1 Corinthians 3:11 states, 'For no one can lay any foundation other than the one already laid, which is Jesus Christ.' Jesus was designating Peter from among the twelve Apostles for further leadership responsibilities.

Jesus Christ is the foundation of the church, and Peter was one of the builders. 1 Peter 2:4-5 states; "As you come to him, the living Stone - rejected by humans but chosen by God and precious to him - you also, like living stones, are being built into a spiritual house to be a holy priesthood, offering spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ." Peter was a living stone on which Christ entrusted the work of building the church.

We too are living stones, a chosen people who have been reunited with God through Holy Baptism, empowered by the Holy Spirit through Confirmation and the Holy Eucharist, to carry forward the work of Christ through the church. It is therefore our responsibility to be open to the Holy Spirit for directions, so we can be led in discovering ways in which we can build the church, which will transform society and eventually turn the hearts of people to God.
