- To teach, baptize and nurture new believers. (Matthew 28:18-20)
- To respond to human needs by loving service. (Matt.25:31-46)
- To seek to transform the unjust structures of society. (Luke 4: 18-19)
- To strive to safeguard the integrity of creation, and sustain and renew the life of the earth. (Genesis 2:15)

Mission as celebration and thanksgiving

An important feature of Anglicanism is our belief that worship is central to our common life. But worship is not just something we do alongside our witness to the good news: worship is itself a witness to the world, It is a sign that all of life is holy, that hope and meaning can be found in offering ourselves to God (Rom. 12:1). And each time we celebrate the Eucharist, we 'proclaim the Lord's death until he comes' (1Cor. 11:26). Our liturgical life is a vital dimension of our mission calling; and although it is not included in the Five Marks, it undergirds the form of public witness listed there.
