

Dear People of God:

On Trinity Sunday, we focus on a mystery which so many of us can barely understand; the nature of God who is both high and deep, beyond us yet within, encompassing all that has been, and is, and is yet to come? The eternal creator, the source of life and the fountain of love, who has redeemed and sustains his creation. I share with you an excerpt from **Demonstration of the Apostolic Preaching** (Page 39-40), by Church Father **Irenaeus** (2nd c. AD-c.202)

“God prepared a place for humanity which was better than this world ...a paradise of such beauty and goodness that the Word of God constantly walked in it, and talked with humanity; prefiguring that future time when he would live with human beings and talk with them, associating with human beings and teaching them righteousness. But humanity was a child; and its mind was not yet fully mature; and thus humanity was easily led astray by the deceiver. This is the rule of our faith, the foundation of the building, and what gives support to our behaviour.

God the Father uncreated, who is uncontained, invisible, one God, creator of the universe, this is the first article of our faith. And the second is: *The Word of God*, the Son of God, our Lord Jesus Christ, who appeared to the prophets according to their way of prophesying, and according to the dispensation of the Father. Through him all things were created. Furthermore, in the fullness of time, in order to gather all things to himself, he became a human being amongst human beings, capable of being seen and touched, to destroy death, bring life, and restore fellowship between God and humanity. And the third article is:

The Holy Spirit, through whom the prophets prophesied, and our forebears learned of God and the righteous were led in the paths of justice, and who, in the fullness of time, was poured out in a new way on our human nature in order to renew humanity throughout the entire world in the sight of God”.
