What does it mean that everything belongs to God?

- God made it, so there for He has the right of ownership - Deut. 10:14
 - Even our own selves belong to God - Ezekiel 18:4
 - God doesn't owe anyone because He preexisted - Job 41:11
- Remember that we come with nothing and leave with nothing. God owns everything which means - everything, then, that we have in this life is simply loaned to us temporarily.

Therefore, we do not resist, in order to serve the good, by ignoring the demands of justice for retribution. If we are provoked and do not reply in kind, we should overcome the enemy by seeking to do good to them. (*Romans Christian Commentary*, 2005)
