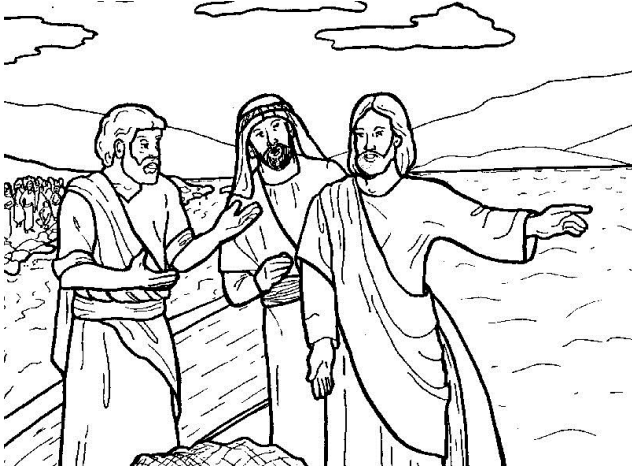

## Mission & Evangelism

Evangelism is an integral part of the mission of the church. Evangelism, simply put is taking advantage of opportunities to share what you know about Jesus, with others for the purpose of leading people into a personal relationship with God.

Please do not be confused. Evangelism is not a method or a program. Often, when the word is mentioned, people get mental pictures of putting up a tent, going door to door, waving a Bible on a street corner and so on. These methods are valid ways to reach those who need to hear, but at the heart of the matter is the idea of building relationships between people and God.

It is God's greatest desire to spend the rest of eternity with you and me. That is an awesome truth that people need to know!!

The word 'Evangelism' does not actually appear in the Scriptures. The word 'Evangelist' does. By definition, an evangelist is "a preacher of the Gospel." In the Bible, Jesus gives a command to His disciples, that carries down to our generation.

**"Go into all the world and preach the Gospel to every creature."  
Mark 16:15**

The Gospel, the good news, at its core is simply the fact that Jesus Christ came and died on a cross for the sins of all mankind and rose again on the third day. Because of this single act of love and mercy on the part of God, we have the opportunity and privilege of coming into a personal relationship with Him.
