### Did you know?

Lambs are almost exclusively symbolic in the Bible. They represented innocence and gentleness. God's care for His people was often expressed in terms of a shepherd watching over His lambs. Unblemished lambs were to be sacrificed for people's sins, and so Jesus being called the Lamb of God refers to His status of being innocent – the one who was sacrificed to take away the sins of the world. (David Howard and Gary Burge, *Fascinating Bible Facts*, 1997).
