

Faith Formation and Christian Education

Did you know?

The season of Epiphany consists of four to nine weeks. The length of the season varies according to the date of Easter. It begins on the Feast of the Epiphany (January 6) through to the Tuesday before Ash Wednesday. The gospel stories of this season describe various events of Jesus' divinity [and the light that He brings to those in darkness]. As a result, stories during this season include the visitation of the Magi, the Baptism of our Lord, the calling of the disciples, the wedding at Cana, the Transfiguration, and various miracles and teachings of Jesus.
