

The Great Commission is an instructive point of reference in helping us to assess our situation as disciples of Jesus, especially since it was a command given by our Lord, just before His departure from this earth. This was the commission given to the disciples in Matthew 28:19-20, "...Go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."

The word "go" is a verb that denotes action. Discipleship therefore is not passive, but is marked by the 'Followers of Christ' going out into the world to make Christ known. Additionally, we are charged with three responsibilities: 1) to make disciples 2) to baptize new believers 3) to teach the new believer/disciples. In examining the position of the Anglican Church on this matter, one can appreciate that this is nicely summarized in the second Mark of Mission, which is to "teach, baptize and nurture new believers". As disciples therefore, we have a tremendous task to carry out, especially since we are being challenged to see ourselves as trainers of trainers.

A disciple is a follower of Christ; that is an individual who is committed to doing the will of God by walking in the footsteps of Jesus. However, what does it mean 'to walk in the way of Jesus'? To walk in the way of Jesus means that we are to demonstrate a sense of care for the needs of others, especially as it relates to their physical, spiritual, emotional and psychological needs.

The concept of 'discipling', therefore, does not involve sitting down at church and waiting for members to come in to minister to them. It is a verb and so its meaning connotes a movement to getting things done. To be a disciple therefore is not only confined to proclaiming the Word of God with our lips, but also getting involved in the lives of the people in the surrounding community. In this way, others may come to experience the love and works of Jesus, through the help and support that they get from us - the Church.

We extend a warm welcome to our visitors and friends who have come to experience the spirit of God.
