BISHOP'S MESSAGE FOR YOUTH MONTH

I am, indeed pleased to proffer greetings to our young people as they embark on yet another month of activities, dubbed 'Youth Month 2018'.

Earlier this year, our Deanery Youth Coordinators and representatives from the Anglican Youth Fellowship met for a weekend of reflection at the Hillcrest Diocesan Retreat Centre, Browns Town. Emanating from that engagement was the theme 'Teaching to Reach'. Anchored by the first Mark of Mission, 'To teach, baptize and nurture new believers,' it highlights the importance of equipping the saints for ministry and mission with a particular focus on peer evangelism.

Also, during this month, the Division of Youth Ministry will engage a number of youths throughout the Diocese at our Youth Caucus as together we seek to learn from each other, hear the views of our young people on matters of Governance, Crime, Justice, and Mission. This will help, but the Church has to offer programmes to cater more directly to the needs of our youth as well as helping to better prepare our youth representative who will attend Synod 2019 to contribute to the deliberations there.

I hope and pray that services in each congregation to mark this observance will be well attended. It is my hope that the richness of the worship and fellowship will provide the momentum for a wide range of youth activities in the local congregations culminating with the large Regional Youth Rallies on Saturday, November 24.
