Our Challenges

- **Financial** - Ongoing sustainable funding to maintain programmes & infrastructure
- **Volunteerism** – Insufficient volunteers to support our outreach activities
- **Spiritual growth** – consistent presence of spiritual leaders and require Sunday school teachers and mentors
- **Social environment** –
 - Culture of hopelessness & apathy
 - Theft of electricity & water
 - Ongoing eruption of gang violence
 - High unemployment, low skills level
