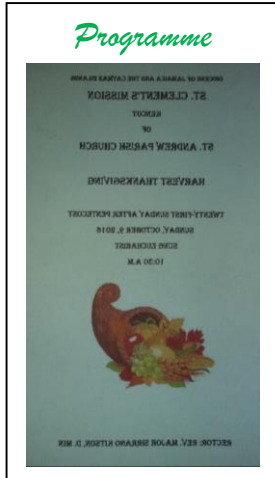


On **October 9, 2016 at 10:30 a.m.**, the **St. Clement's Mission**, Kencot, celebrated
