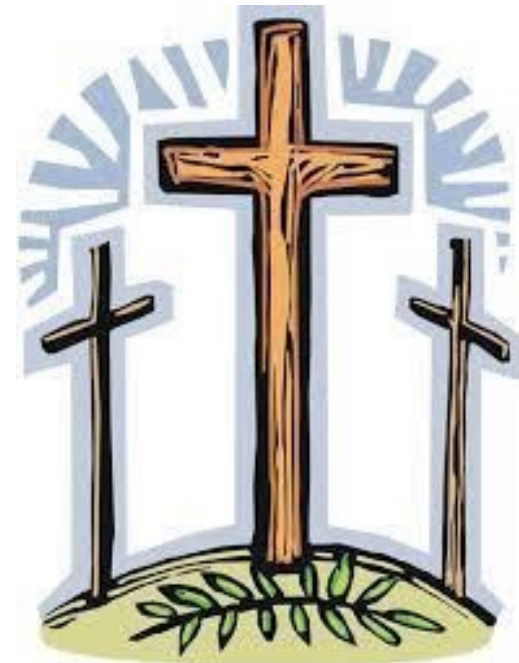

Let us remember our baptismal commitment as disciples of Jesus to demonstrate our Lord's Sacrificial love through our lives to those around us.*

### **THE CELEBRATION OF THE LORD'S PASSION**

The ministers enter in silence. All kneel, while the Celebrant kneels before the Altar.

The Choir sings 651 It is a thing most wonderful Verses 1,4,6 & 7.

### **THE MINISTRY OF THE WORD** (All sit)

**First Reading:** Isaiah 52:13 - 53:12

**Psalm:** 22:1-21 page 493 (Paraphrased verses led by the choir)

**Response: My God, my God why have you abandoned me?**

**Second Reading:** Hebrews 10: 16 - 25

**Gradual Hymn** 669 - There is a green hill far away

**The Gospel:** The Passion of our Lord Jesus Christ according to John

**Sermon:** Rev. Canon Sirrano Kitson

**Hymn** 133 Jesus, keep me near the cross

### **THE SOLEMN INTERCESSION** page 238 - 242

The people stand for prayer. At the end of each petition silence is observed, then follows the Collects.

### **Hymn** O Come and mourn with me awhile

1. O come and mourn with me awhile;  
O come ye to the Savior's side;  
O come, together let us mourn;  
Jesus, our Lord, is crucified.
2. Have we no tears to shed for him,  
while soldiers scoff and Jews deride?  
Ah! look how patiently he hangs;

### **MEDITATION ON THE CROSS OF JESUS** page 242

A wooden Cross is brought into the church in procession and stations (stops) are made as the following is said:

Leader: *This is the wood of the cross on which hung the Saviour of the world.*
