The gospel narrative for today presents us with one of the appearance encounters that Jesus, our Risen Lord had with his disciples. It is instructive to note that although many of the accounts surrounding the Passion and the Discovery of the empty tomb are recorded in different gospels, none of the "appearance stories" is repeated in more than one Gospel. This indicates that the risen Jesus interacts with different followers, at different times and in different places to reveal His presence to His disciples. Jesus' conversation and encounter with two friends on the Emmaus Road demonstrates to us that, whatever our circumstances, the risen Jesus journeys with us, whether we know it or not.

Working with the members of the St Andrew Parish Church, the missions of St. Clement's and St Thomas, as well as the communities and the schools they serve, has been a tremendous learning and rewarding experience which I will always treasure. I must express my sincere appreciation for your welcoming warmth, your generous support for me and my family, your guidance and your willingness to share and allow me to be a part of your lives, albeit for a short time.
