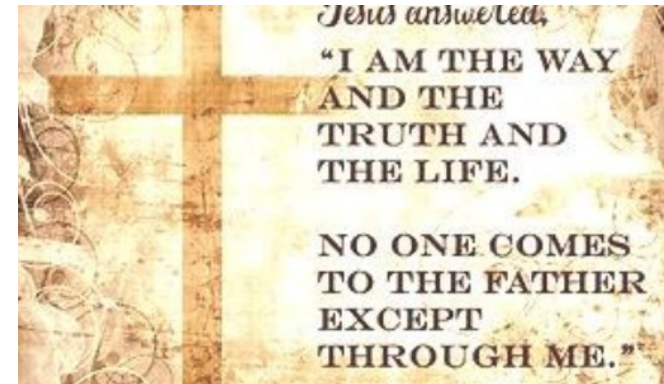

The Archbishop's Message Cont'd.

My brothers, Sisters and Youth in the Diocese:

Our families may not be able to worship in our usual spaces in church but, we need to remain connected to our faith in Christ through the new routines of home worship and Bible Study. Now is the time to pray together as families by learning and using the services of the church in Morning and Evening prayer to nurture our faith. Let us begin each day with family Morning Prayer led by each member, including our children, and conclude each night with Evening prayer or Compline, if available. Let us be diligent in sharing the stories of the Bible with our children so that they may learn of the faithfulness of a loving God in whom we place our hope and trust.

The learning environment of our children has been greatly altered. They no longer put on uniforms and go out to sit in a classroom, but they must still study and learn using online platforms, where these are available, or through written work diligently delivered by their teachers. As we utilize these new ways of teaching and learning, may we exercise patience and understanding with each other as we learn together. As we encourage our children to move to the new modes of learning, may we not forget that they have different learning styles and abilities. Let us encourage them to give their best effort and to work with them through the areas where they have their greatest difficulties.

Our children are spending more time at home and in the community. We encourage every adult to look out for the welfare and safety of our children. May we seek to help and not to hinder them. May we exercise the courage to report cases of abuse and neglect and so safeguard those who are the weakest among us.

The children of our congregations are away from us during this time, and they and the joy and laughter that they bring are sorely missed. However even as we journey physically apart, may we continue to reach out using the means available to encourage their growth as young people and disciples. May we continue to provide our children with good examples for them to emulate and to encourage their faith journey. As we consider our plans for worship and fellowship may we include our children and young people in the process as they have much to offer to enrich our lives together as the church.
