On this Trinity Sunday, we focus on a mystery which so many of us can barely understand; the nature of God who is both high and deep, beyond us yet within, encompassing all that has been, and is, and is yet to come. Our eternal creator, the source of life and the fountain of love, has redeemed and sustains His creation. I share with you a quote from the Synthesis Commentary on the doctrine of the Trinity.

“To speak of the Trinity, the One God who is made known to us as the Creator of all, the redeeming Christ and the life-giving Spirit, is to use a shorthand way of expressing the depths of the faith. Without the Trinity holding us accountable, we might be tempted to worship a one-dimensional deity. This full view of God lifts up a God who is more than a Creator who made the world out of nothing, more than the God of the big-bang theory who began the universe and then left it to run on its own. We do not worship a process, but a provider who continues to create and move among us. Each day is a new day, thanks to the Spirit of God in our midst. God's work in Jesus is the prime example of God's continuing creative and redeeming work among us and despite us. This is God the compassionate and merciful, who bears on his heart for all time the sorrow and pain of the world. This is the God enthroned in majesty who answers the longings of the ages and shows us his glory. This is the God who is Trinity of persons, Father, Son and Holy Spirit.”

The God to whom Jesus prayed is worshiped, in Spirit, in truth and in love. It is this God that we worship and served for the building of His Kingdom of Justice, Peace and Joy.

We extend a warm welcome to The Most Rev. Dr. Howard Gregory and Mrs. Gregory also to all our visitors who are worshipping with us today and for those who are viewing online.

Did you Know?

Trinity Sunday is the first Sunday after Pentecost when we honour the Holy Trinity - the Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Although the word "trinity" does not appear in Scripture, it is taught in Matthew 28:18-20 and 2 Corinthians 13:14 (and many other biblical passages). On Trinity Sunday, the Christian Church ponders with joy and thanksgiving what the Father, Son and Holy Spirit have done to accomplish the salvation of sinful humanity. We remember the Father as our Creator, the Son as our Saviour and the Holy Spirit as our Comforter and Guide.
