**The Rector is out of Office on Mondays**

“There are some people who live in peace with themselves, and are also at peace with others. There are some who neither enjoy peace in their own lives, nor leave others in peace – they are a burden to other people and even more of a burden to themselves. There are others who not only keep themselves in peace but are always ready to guide others back to peace” (Imitation of Christ, Thomas a’ Kempis)

In the midst of social distancing and not being able to be in the company of family members and friends, we may feel isolated, alone and disconnected despite communicating through the cell phone. Face to face interaction is special and cannot be substituted by any means. As Jesus told His disciples about His impending departure in John chapter fourteen, He recognized that they were disappointed and sad, as they would not see Him again face to face and would be in the world, isolated and alone without His presence. In response, Jesus assured them that, His risen presence would be revealed to them through the work of the Holy Spirit (John 14:25-26). It is the Holy Spirit that ignites within us God’s peace, God’s love and God’s presence which will alleviate our fears and anxiety.

This peace which has been bestowed on Jesus’ disciples through the indwelling of the Holy Spirit is not the absence of strife or conflict, rather it is the intimate union of the divine within us. The evidence of this union affects our spiritual and emotional health, as it is through our experience of intimacy with God’s love, that we receive that peace which provides safety and security for our wellbeing. We demonstrate our love for God through our relationships which are infected by our experience of God’s peace. In other words, whenever we experience God’s peace in the heart of our soul, we will be at peace in our relationship with others.

The peace that God gives to us is a direct product and fruit of the Holy Spirit’s presence within us and includes being in harmony with oneself (Gal 5:23). This peace is more than contentment; it is a wholeness that comes through knowing and experiencing an overwhelming embrace of God’s loving presence, which gives us everlasting joy both for the present moment and for eternity.

We extend a warm welcome to all our visitors who are worshipping with us today and to those who are viewing online.
