Did you know that?

"The sacraments are outward and visible signs of inward and spiritual grace, given by Christ as sure and certain means by which we receive that grace (BCP; p108). We use many things to signify an inner meaning, such as flags, paper money, words, or shaking hands. A sacrament is such an act or sign, given us by Christ or ordained by the church according to guidance of the Holy Spirit. We can receive God's grace in other ways, but since the sacraments are ordained by God, they are a pledge and an assurance that through them we may receive God's grace".

Quote for Reflection

Sacraments are meant to help us encounter Jesus our risen Lord through symbols and words. They originated with Jesus' words and actions, but historically accumulated additional symbols and gestures which people found helpful in making Jesus' presence felt. Through the sacraments we invite Jesus into our personal lives by celebrating with other Christians what we are, and what we hope to become in him. It is a privilege to have people who will celebrate these sacred mysteries with us".
