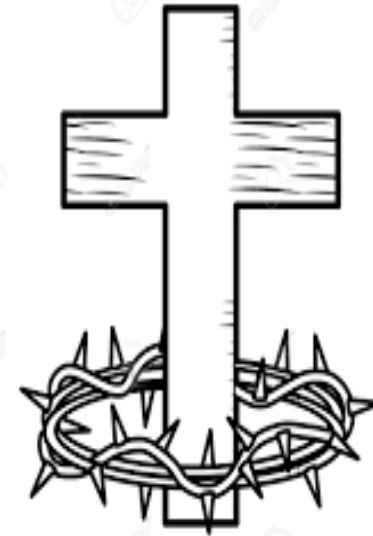

GOOD FRIDAY

9:00 a.m.

April 02, 2021

Good Friday is the most solemn day of Holy Week. In awe and reverence, we stand before the Cross on which our Saviour died and meditate on the depth of the father's love for us. Let us remember our baptismal commitment as disciples of Jesus to demonstrate our Lord's Sacrificial love through our lives to those around us.

THE CELEBRATION OF THE LORD'S PASSION

The ministers enter in silence. All kneel, while the Celebrant kneels before the Altar.

The Choir sings "Jesu word of God Incarnate" W.A. Mozart

Introduction, Confession and Collect for the Day page 236

THE MINISTRY OF THE WORD (All sit)

First Reading: Isaiah 52:13 - 53:12

Psalm: 22:1-21 page 493 (Paraphrased verses led by the choir)

Response: My God, my God why have you abandoned me?

Second Reading: Hebrews 10: 16 - 25

Gradual Hymn 669 - There is a green hill far away

The Gospel: The Passion of our Lord Jesus Christ according to John

THE SOLEMN INTERCESSION page 238 - 242

The people stand for prayer. At the end of each petition silence is observed, then follows the Collects.

1. O come and mourn with me awhile;
O come ye to the Saviour's side;
O come, together let us mourn;
Jesus, our Lord, is crucified.
2. Have we no tears to shed for him,
while soldiers scoff and foes deride?
Ah! look how patiently he hangs;
Jesus, our Lord, is crucified.
3. Seven times He spoke, seven words of love;
And all three hours His silence cried
For mercy on the souls of men
Jesus, our Lord, is crucified.
4. O love of God! O sin of man!
In this dread act your strength is tried;
and victory remains with love;
for He, our Lord, is crucified.

MEDITATION ON THE CROSS OF JESUS page 242

A wooden Cross is brought into the church in procession and stations (stops) are made as the following is said:

Leader: *This is the wood of the cross on which hung the Saviour of the world.*

People: Come let us worship.
