The Church Army Mission 2021 consists of 6 activities. We looked at four last week. The remaining two are:

Mission infiltration – To strengthen existing organizations in the Church – the MU, BSA, WA, AYP and the Young Adults, making them aware that they too are called to be evangelists and to remind them that this is what they are called to do. “Christ to be known, lives to be transformed, Christ is to lead your life”.

Footprints -This Ministry calls for each person to prayerfully choose one person who may not have a relationship with God, to journey alongside them intentionally, for a year supporting and sharing with them to bring them to a saving knowledge of God in Christ.
