**Did you know?**

The church understands healing in a holistic way. Thus, healing is not just a physical matter. It is for this reason that our catechism states that in the anointing of the sick with oil, “God’s grace is given for the healing of spirit, mind and body” (BCP, pg 413). Being truly healthy then can be seen as a balance created by the wellness of mind, body and soul, as their interdependent actions give way to wholeness.

“The work of Jesus Christ is to a great extent an account of healing: restoring, curing, making whole. In part, the personal activity of assisting in the healing of others helps to align our lives with Christ. Participating in this healing process gives our lives meaning.
