Did you know?

Our Caribbean is at a huge risk due to the rise in the planet's temperature and its associated conditions. Human and non-human activities are the cause. The primary contributor to the rise is an increase in the release of greenhouse gases such as Carbon Dioxide (CO_2) into the atmosphere. These gases trap heat and make our planet warmer. For the Caribbean, a warmer planet means decreased rainfall, long periods of drought, more frequent extreme storms, sea-level rise, destroyed coastlines and low-line developments. Stewardship of God's creation means we (individually and collectively) must reduce our CO_2 emissions (our Carbon footprint).
