Did you know?

The organ played a prominent role in the early days of reggae. The traditional reggae organ fills came primarily from the Hammond B3 organ. The organ is used to produce a shuffle sound. All of the top reggae bands use a reggae organ - the Wailers, Third World, UB40 and Iration are among the many which do. It has made a comeback in the "reggae revival." In order to get the roots reggae sound, the reggae organ sound is essential. Given their flexibility, however, keyboards are mostly used these days as a substitute for the traditional reggae organ.

Quote for reflection

"Calypso is much more than a song. It is expressive of a culture or a way of life. This culture is also captured in reggae...Calypso [and reggae] performs a political and prophetic function and in so doing offers a subtle challenge to authority, just as Jesus challenged the political and religious leaders of his day. Over the years it has developed into an authentic Caribbean phenomenon and has gained the respect of all classes of people. With justification, we may speak of the liberating role of calypso and reggae."
