Did you know?

The penitential season of Lent begins with Ash Wednesday, designated the first of two fast days (the other being Good Friday), and extends to Easter Eve. The collect for Ash Wednesday is one of the ancient prayers of the Church. It can be traced to the 8th century. It is inspired by Psalm 51. When Archbishop Cranmer crafted the first Prayer Book, he included the collect and made some adjustments to it. In times past, the collect was used daily in Lent.

“The Season of Lent is like a roller coaster ride with emotions that are down and up again and again as the story of our salvation makes plain our sinful ways and the cost of our redemption. We begin with Ash Wednesday where we roughly bump up against our mortality. Here we know that sin and death are real, and they are real not just for someone else. Sin and death are real for us... [We] do know how the story ends and therefore in the midst of austerity and fasting we remember our faithful Savior and the Easter declaration that life is always victorious over our death, always!”
