**Did you know ?**

Much focus is given to prayer in Lent. Prayer has always been a daily practice for Christians. The prayer that Jesus gave us, known as “the Lord’s Prayer”, presents us a guide as to what we are to talk to God about. The prayer is to be found in Matthew 6:9-13 and in Luke 11:2-4. In our prayers, we should **1)** acknowledge God as our caring parent, we should ask **2)** that God be revered by everyone, **3)** that God’s desire for the world be fulfilled, **4)** that God provide for our needs, **5)** that God help us to have good relationships, and **6)** that God guard us in the face of evil.

A person prays in a certain manner when cheerful and in another when weighed down by sadness or a sense of hopelessness.
