**Did you know ?**

Thursday of this week is Ascension Day. The statue in the All Souls' Chapel commemorates this Feast. The statue is called *Christ Ascending*. It was made by Laura Facey-Cooper, and was dedicated by Bishop Spence on Ascension Day, May 24, 2001. Ascension Day falls forty days after Easter day, and it commemorates Christ's last visible appearance to his followers. It is one of the most universally celebrated Feast days, and is one of the earliest Christian Feasts, dating back to as early as the fourth century. The first of the three collects for the Day alludes to Bible verses such as Ephesians 4:10 and Matthew 28:20. Together, they speak of Christ's glorification and of his abiding presence. These themes are to be repeated on Whitsunday.

**Quote for reflection**

"Christ is already in that place of peace, which is all in all. He is on the right hand of God. He is hidden in the brightness of the radiance which issues from the everlasting throne. He is in the very abyss of peace, where there is no voice of tumult or distress, but a deep stillness--stillness, that greatest and most awful of all goods which we can fancy; that most perfect of joys, the utter profound, ineffable tranquillity of the Divine Essence. He has entered into His rest. That is our home; here we are on a pilgrimage, and Christ calls us to His many mansions which He has prepared." *John Henry Newman*
