**Faith Formation and Christian Education**

**Did you know ?**

In his book “Christ and Culture,” Richard Niebuhr outlines three ways in which Christians have sought to live faithfully for Christ as they relate to the culture surrounding them. The first of these approaches is opposition to culture (Christ against culture). This approach is characterised by absolute loyalty to Christ and the church and entails a rejection of culture and society. The lines between the church and the world are sharp because the church is a community whose existence judges the world.

**Quote for reflection**

“This Conference recognises that culture is the context in which people find their identity. [It] affirms that God’s love extends to people of every culture and that the Gospel judges every culture according to the Gospel’s own criteria of truth, challenging some aspects of culture while endorsing and transforming others for the benefit of the Church and society.” *Lambeth Conference, Resolution 22a-b, 1988*
