Faith Formation and Christian Education

Did you know ?

In his book “Christ and Culture,” Richard Niebuhr outlines three ways in which Christians have sought to live faithfully for Christ as they relate to the culture surrounding them. He called the third of these approaches “Christ above culture.” This is a medial position between the first two. This approach regards cultural expressions as basically good. Instead of choosing between Christ and culture, its proponents argue, we are to rely on both, as God uses the best elements of culture to give people what they cannot achieve independently. Aspects of culture, however, may need to be augmented or perfected by Christian revelation and the work of the church, with Christ supreme over both.

Quote for reflection

“God’s reign consists of people in the process of redemption, cooperating with God in the redemption of the world. Kingdom people are impelled by a sense of mission and a covenant of responsibility toward the world. They break out of spiritual lukewarmness and privatized religion. People of the Kingdom are engaged always in the process of moral conversion and behavioural faith, they are a people who make peace and work for justice.” *Patrick J Brennan in Re-imagining Evangelization*
