DID YOU KNOW

A plaque with a listing of the 10 Commandments is to be found behind the altar in this Church! The 10 Commandments is also known as the "Decalogue." It is displayed in many of our older churches. So are the Lord's Prayer and the Apostles' Creed. This is an 18th century practice that developed in European countries such as England. According to our church's catechism, the 10 Commandments provides the clearest summary of what God desires of us. They "were given to define our relationship with God and our neighbours" (BCP 391).

QUOTE FOR REFLECTION

"The Ten Commandments begin with the identification of the God who liberated Israel from Egypt. The word 'Egypt' refers to Pharaoh, and Pharaoh is the abusive, brutalising king of Egypt who practiced and exploited a concentration of power and wealth....They [the Ten Commandments] are rules for freedom and justice that contrast with the bondage and injustice of Pharaoh. The covenant at Sinai is a warning that if you do not keep these commandments, you will be back in the grip of Pharaoh and his insatiable demands. Thus, the Ten Commandments are strategies for staying emancipated once you get away from Pharaoh." - Walter Bruggemann
