Did you know?

The Stations of the Cross, also known as the Way of the Cross, is a traditional devotion that originated in medieval Europe. It consists of fourteen images or "stations" that depict the final hours of Jesus Christ's life, from his condemnation to his crucifixion and burial. The devotion is intended to help us meditate on the Passion of Christ and to enter into his suffering and sacrifice. The practice of the Stations of the Cross is often associated with the season of Lent, particularly on Fridays, and is a powerful way to deepen our faith and spirituality. The stations vary slightly depending on the region, but the main events remain the same.

Ouote for reflection

"The cross is God's word to those who have ears and are willing to hear. So we have to pray to God, that he would give us ears to hear, eyes to see, minds willing to penetrate that mystery, to open up to that mystery in order to see what it is that God is showing us, what God is telling us, what he's doing...The Word of the Cross is ultimately silent.... In the silent depth of the Cross, the silence of God, which is more eloquent than any word, speaks to our silence, the silence within us, in order that we can then understand and grasp and live the deepest mysteries of God." *Fr. Thomas Hopko*
