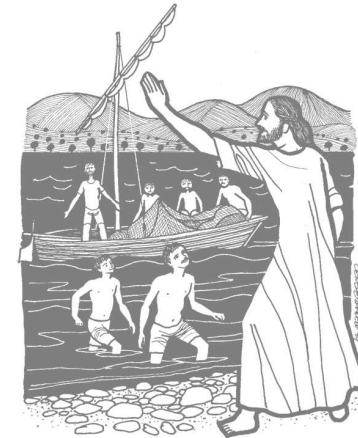

Faith Formation and Christian Education**Did you know?**

In the early Church, baptism and the 'laying on of hands' were performed on converts (Acts 8:17; 19:6). However, the two acts of baptism and 'laying on of hands' became separate in the Western church as baptism began to be carried out at the Easter Vigil in parishes where the bishop was not present. The laying on of hands by the bishop then was to wait until it could be performed later in the sacrament of confirmation. When Christians are confirmed, they reaffirm the promises that were made for them at baptism. They take upon themselves the responsibility to represent Christ in the world. They are Christ's ambassadors – God's co-workers in the world.

Quote for reflection

"Baptism initiates the reality of the new life given amid the present world. It provides participation in the community of the Holy Spirit. It is a sign of the Kingdom of God and of the life of the world to come. Through the gifts of faith, hope, and love, Baptism has a dynamic that embraces the whole of life, extends to all nations, and anticipates the day when every tongue will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord to the glory of God the Father." ~ *Province of the West Indies, Exploring Baptismal Theology*
