Mid-week services and Monday Bible Study are discontinued for the month of August. The Church will be open for prayer on Tuesdays and Fridays, beginning at 9am.

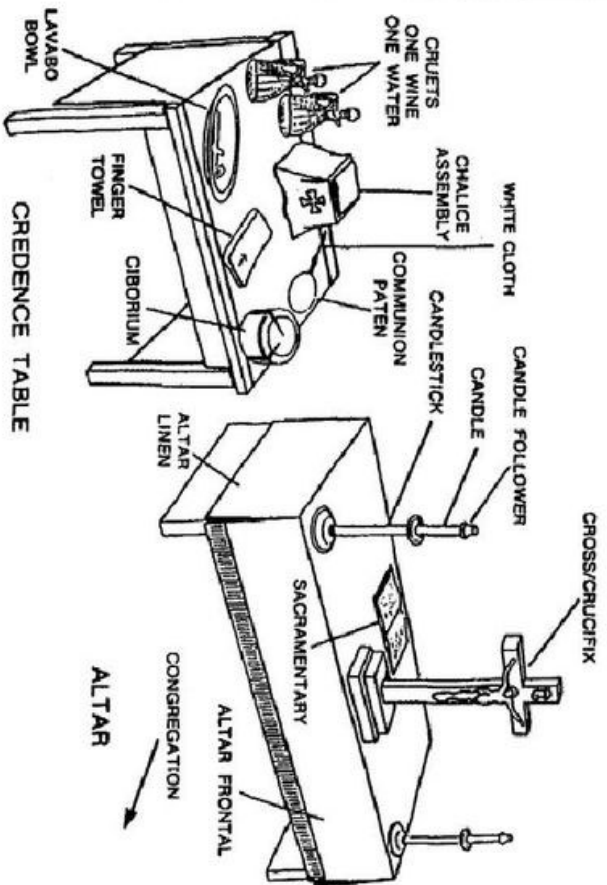
We express thanks to our members who continue to give sacrificially to ensure that the ministry and mission of the church are sustained as we continue to witness and minister in these challenging times.

Tuesday Charity will be on Tuesday the 3rd of September.

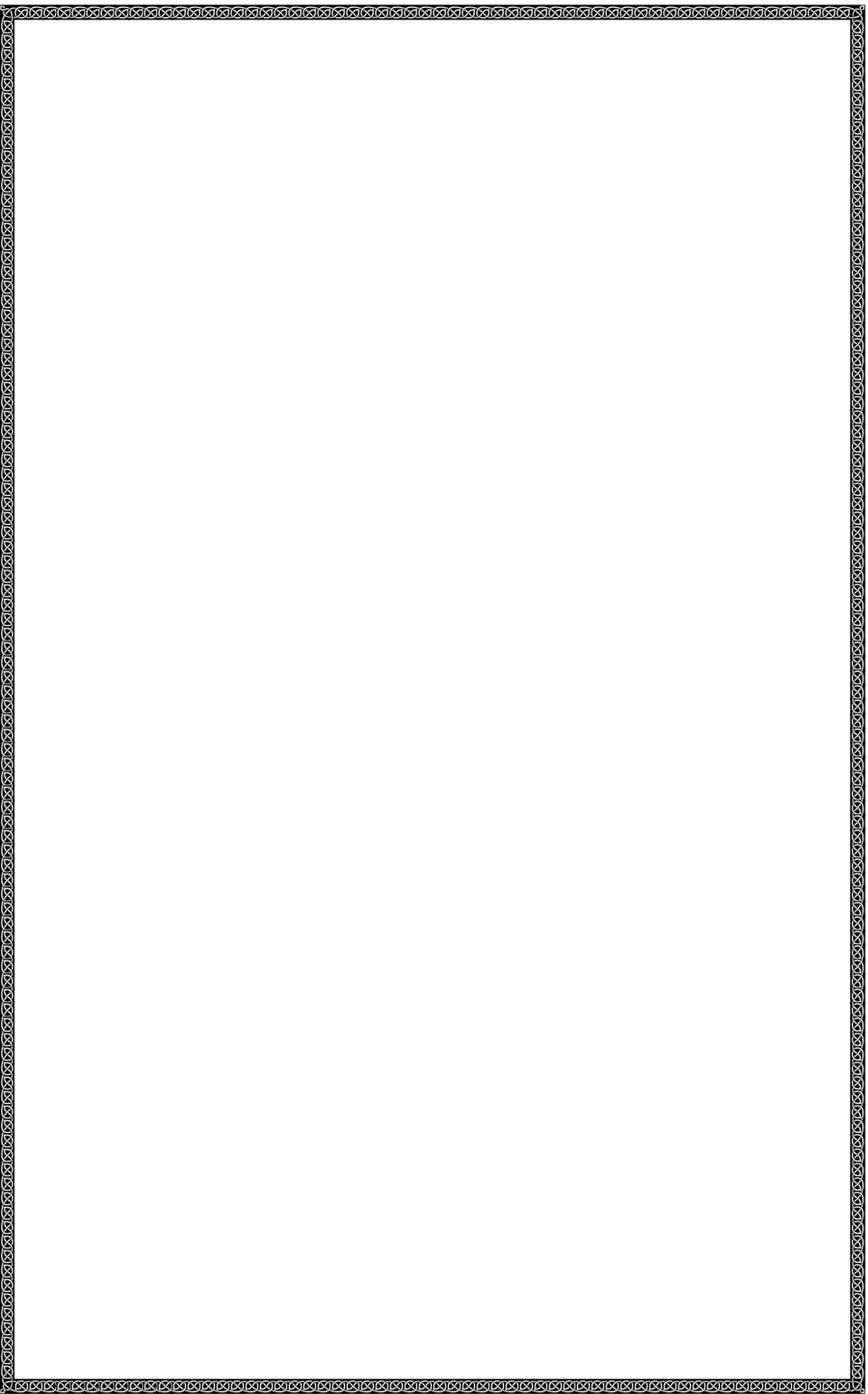
